The Unserved Population

	UNCOVERED POPULATION	Urban/Rural	85% of 28 = 23.8 Million
1	Urban Metropolitan (Low Income)	40% of urban	5.1*
2	Urban Metropolitan (Peri-urban)	20% of urban	2.6
3	Urban Municipal (above poverty line)	10% of urban	1.3
4	Urban Municipal (below poverty line)	30% of urban	3.9
5	Rural (above poverty line)	40% of rural	4.4
6	Rural (below poverty line)	60% of rural	6.6

- Regionwide focused strategy
 - ► RCC & RICCS
- Districtwide implementation
