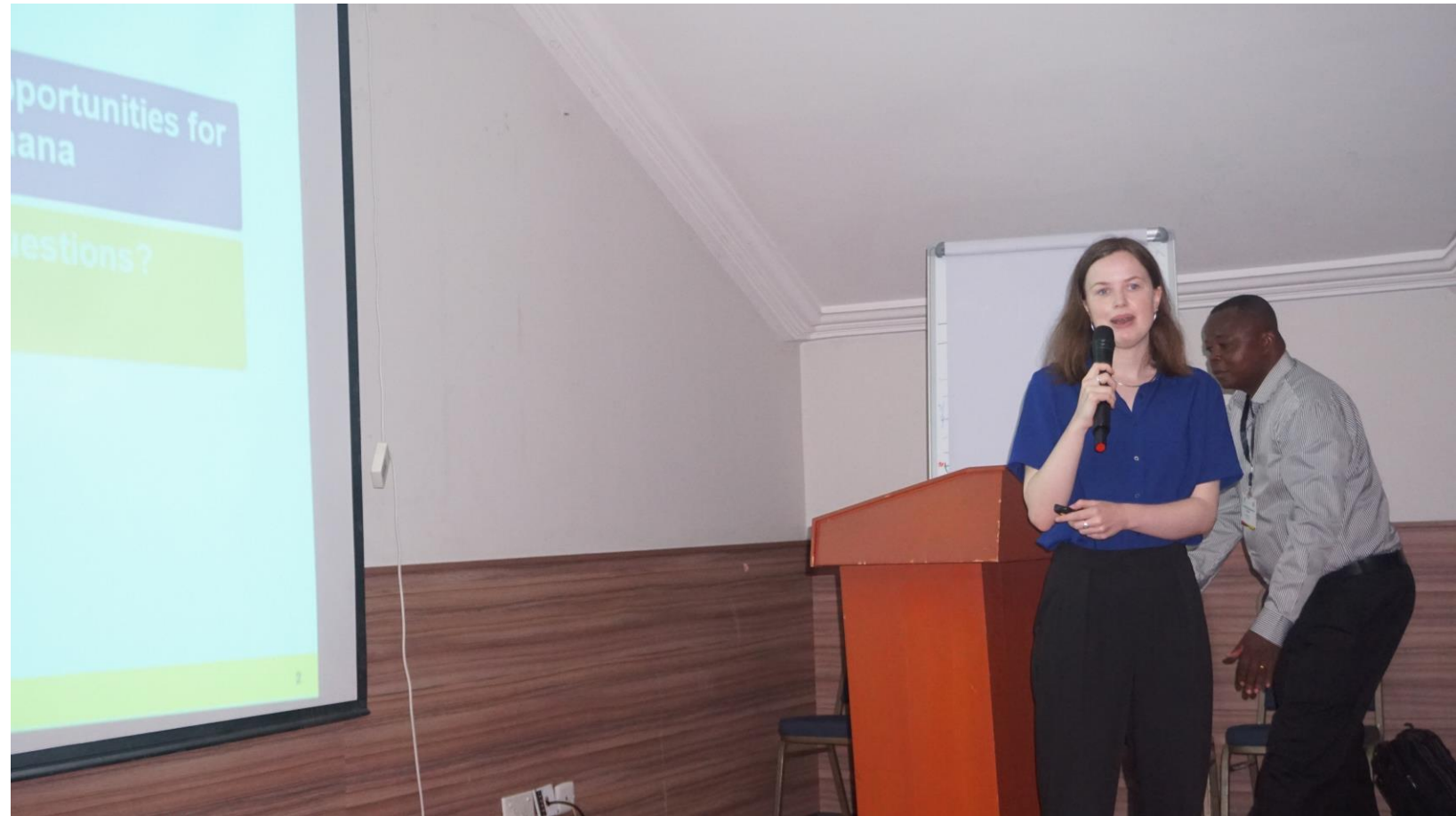

Piloting urban sanitation interventions in Ashiaman, Ho and Tamale. Lessons will feed into the development of a national urban sanitation strategy

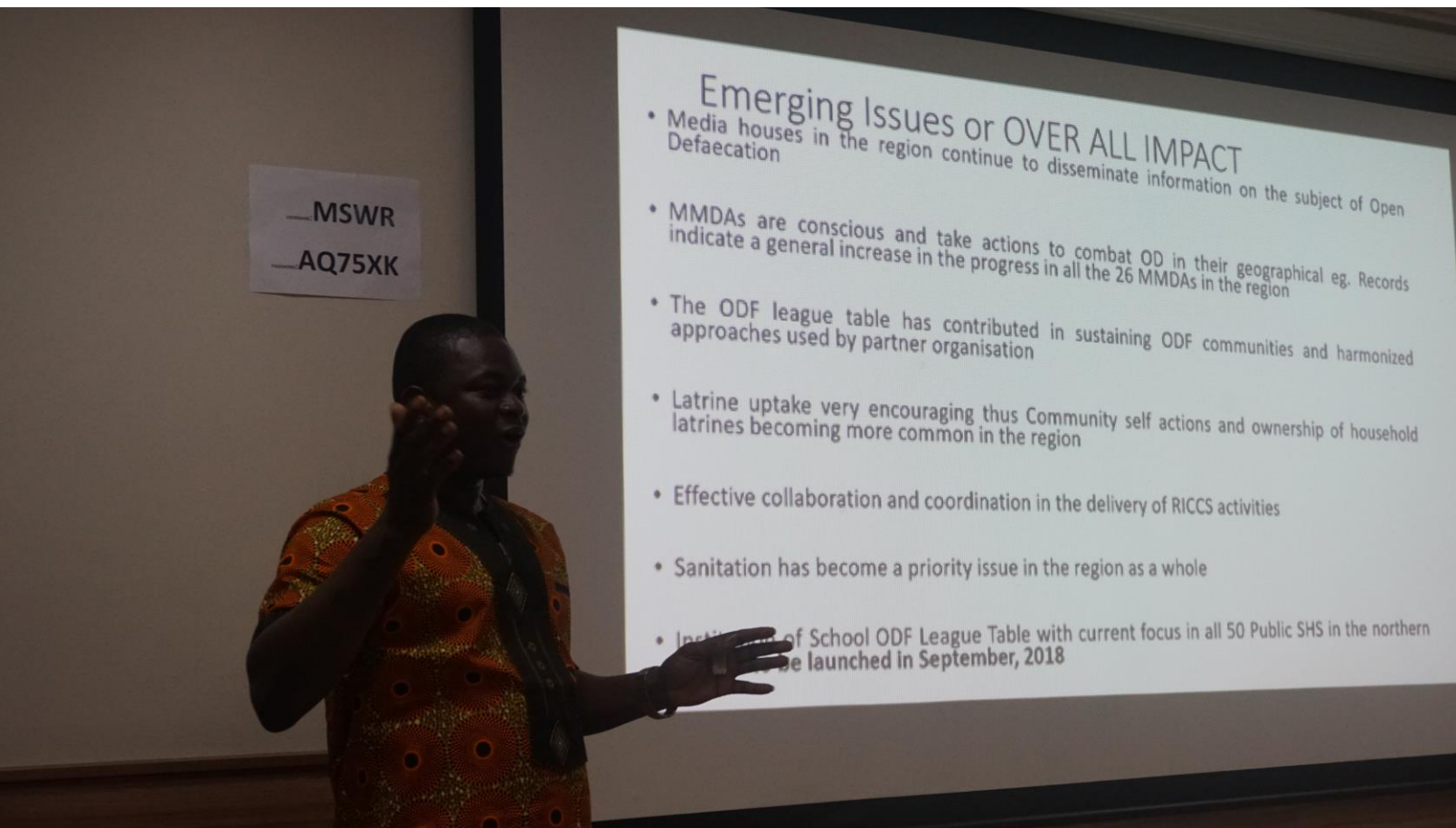
# Pro-poor targeting by MSWR

Where 177 out of 271 communities have been declared ODF in two years, with 72 more prepared for verification



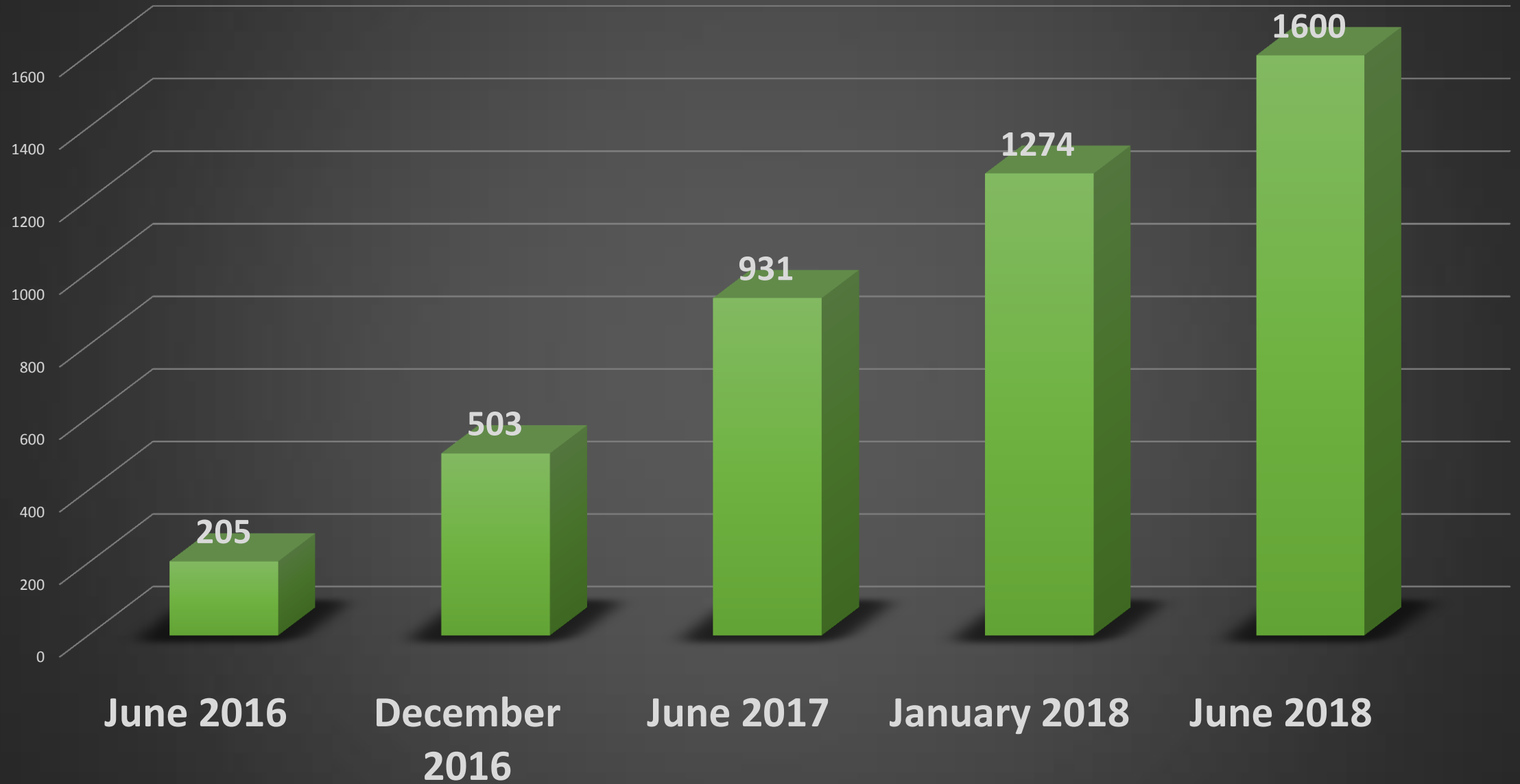

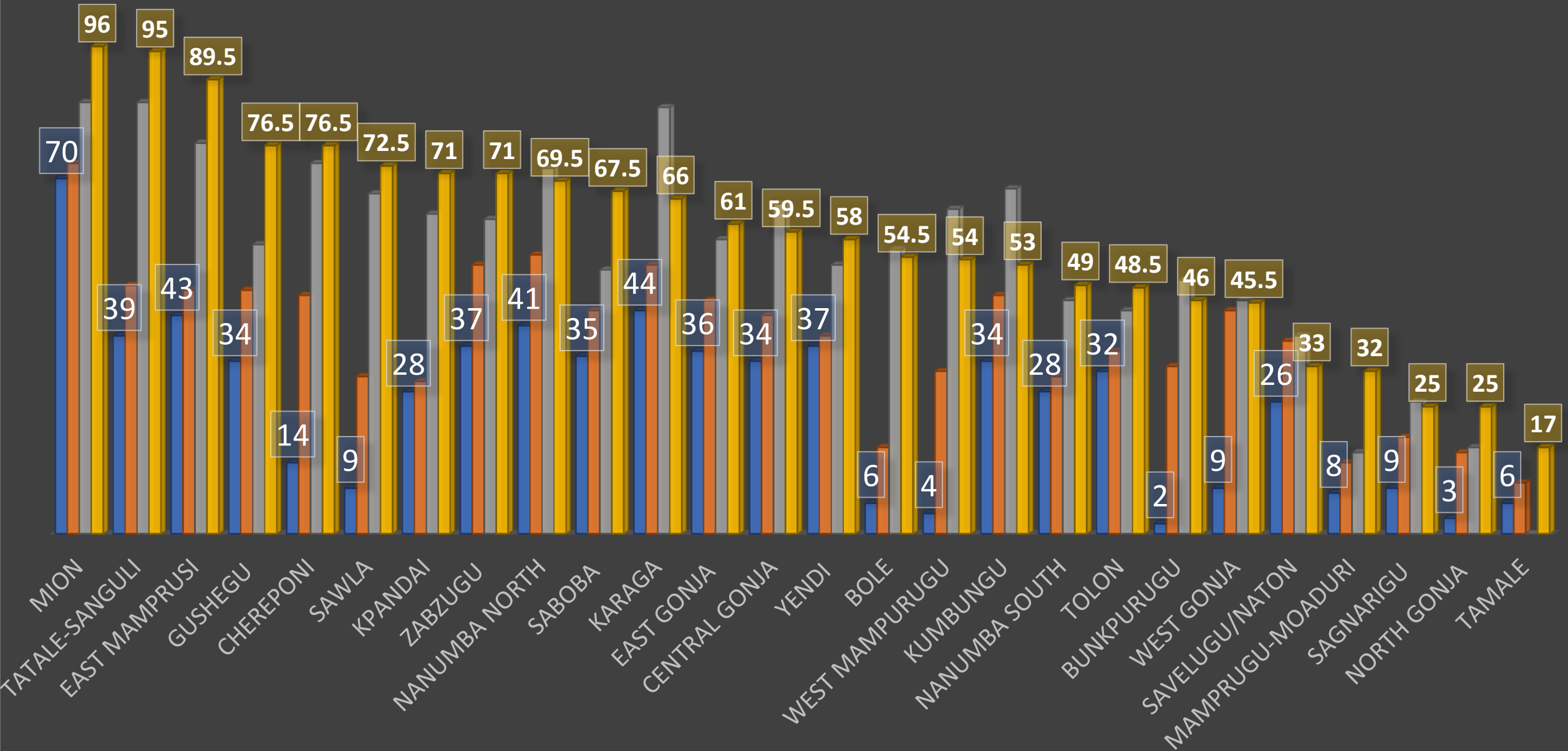
# My Graph of the day ...
